Dress Code Regulations

The Education Act 2006 states the School dress code provides for:

- Standards of what is acceptable in relation to clothing, including headwear and footwear
- Standards of what is acceptable in relation to other aspects of the personal presentation of the students

The Nanango State High School P&C believe that the school's uniform and Dress Code:

- Provides the students of NSHS a unique identity
- Promotes a sense of belonging and pride in NSHS and its community
- Creates a sense of equity for the students
- Is practical in its application to a wide range of physical activities
- Eliminates competition for costly brand name and 'fad' clothing and the wearing of inappropriate or immodest clothing and accessories
- Ensures students observe standards of dress that support Workplace Health and Safety (WPH&S) e.g. appropriate footwear, sun safety

Implementation of the Dress Code

While it is expected that students will comply with the school's dress code the Principal may, in special circumstances, exempt students <u>upon written request</u> from the Parent/Guardian. Grounds on which a Parent/Guardian may seek an exemption are:

- Medical supported by a <u>written statement</u> from a Medical Practitioner (Doctor)
- Religious, cultural or ethnic

Compliance Obligations

- 1. Students not in full School uniform, go to the Administration Office <u>before going to class</u> where clean loan uniform item/s will be provided for the day.
- 2. Parents/Caregivers are asked to contact the school if there are circumstances preventing students wearing the school uniform on a particular day, a clean loan uniform will be provided
- 3. Students wearing makeup will be **expected to remove it**
- 4. Fingernails are to be an appropriate and safe length for school activities e.g. sport
- 5. Student wearing excessive or non-compliant jewellery will be expected to **remove the items**, these items may be confiscated and stored at the office for later return to the student or parent

Non-Compliance

- 1. Parents/Caregivers will be contacted by phone or letter if students persistently breach the School Dress Code. This may include a request for a meeting to resolve difficulties
- 2. Repeated infringements of the Dress Code may result in (not limited to):
 - Preventing the student from attending or participating in activities in which the student is a representative of the school,
 - Detentions for refusal to follow school procedures

Uniform Description

Warm weather

- Nanango State High School maroon and navy blue polo shirt
- Shorts Plain navy blue for boys and girls (mid thigh length)
- Fully enclosed (lace up) school shoes,
- NSHS Bucket Hat (available from school)

Cool Weather as above and:

- Undershirt in plain white or navy,
- Nanango State High School zippered jacket and/or Pullover **
- Navy blue track pants
- School hat (available from school)
- Navy blue beanie (available from school)
- Nanango State High School senior jersey/ jacket (Year 12 students only)
- **A plain maroon pullover with the official NSHS logo embroidered on the upper left chest is permitted

Jewellery (Permitted)

- Watch
- Earrings small and plain (sleepers or studs), no more than 2 in each ear
- 1 flat ring
- Nose stud less than 2mm / extra small

Note – There may be circumstances that jewellery will be required to be removed for Workplace Health and Safety reasons in practical subjects.

Hair

Naturally occurring colours only

Items Not Permitted

- Visible commercial logos on shorts or long pants
- Denim or other Jeans (except by arrangement for Ag shows etc)
- Jackets or pullovers with a hood
- Long socks, leggings or jeggings
- Knitted caps, balaclavas and/or scarves
- Caps with inappropriate logos
- Any jewellery other than that listed above, including visible necklaces and bracelets/bands
- Any hollow or spike piercing expanders/stretchers, Flat solid plugs only are permitted (WPH&S)
- Any metal facial piercings other than extra small nose stud (WPH&S).
- Any facial make-up that is obviously visible

Recommendations / Suggestions

- The school recommends that students have 3 shirts and 3 shorts to allow for washing
- School hat as sun safe headwear
- Any new facial piercings should only be done at the beginning of the long holiday at Christmas to allow ample time for healing
