## Our initiatives include

- Reviewing reading data using Fountas & Pinnell & STAR reader
- Continuing the School Duke of Edinburgh Program
- Continuing the Quick Smart program including Literacy & Numeracy Modules
- Maintaining the Accelerated Reader program for Year 7 & Year 8
- Maintaining the use of online textbooks Junior Maths & Senior General subjects
- Continuing the Youth Worker support position

### Evidenced by:

- Families, students and local employers eg Stanwell have indicated the Duke of Edinburgh program has been “instrumental” in them gaining employment
- STAR Reader testing maths appropriate reading age books linked to students’ ability levels. These results are tracked through pre and post testing
- This Data identifies students to work one on one with TA’s in an intervention program using Fountas & Pinnell. These results are validated by an external expert
- The Quick Smart Program is academically verified by New England University. A comprehensive report is then presented to the school for review
- The Youth Worker has been highly successful with improved student engagement as a result

• Employing 2 Teachers to decrease class sizes in Junior Secondary	\$171,151
• Employing Teacher Aides to administer and record data for the Fountas and Pinnell (Reading), Quick Smart (Numeracy) and Accelerated Reader programs	\$125,612
• Purchasing specific programs and licences to improve Numeracy, Literacy and Reading outcomes e.g. Quick Smart, Accelerated Reader and Mathletics, Turnitin Clickview & PAT Testing	\$ 27,970
• Employing Tech Support (0.2 Full Time Equivalent) to assist with BYOx program across the school	\$ 21,498
• Employing a Youth Worker to work with vulnerable students and their families (0.72) 25 hours	\$ 57,676
