**Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...**

- ➔ Further refine and fully develop the curriculum alignment process in junior secondary, and quality assure the systematic implementation of the Australian Curriculum.
- ➔ Develop processes to engage school leaders in systematically driving, monitoring and evaluating explicit improvement agenda implementation to support improvements in levels of student achievement and exit outcomes.
- ➔ Review the current pedagogical model and refine as required to determine the signature strategies and approaches to successfully engage the range of learners.
- ➔ Devise and enact a whole-school approach to the explicit teaching of reading and writing, and quality assure its enactment in all classrooms.
- ➔ Provide regular opportunities for teachers to analyse and discuss student achievement data to determine next steps for learning.
